Paper Whiteness at The Point of Sale

Makowhiteness Project has prepared a review of the issues concerning Paper Whiteness for consumers.

The reference includes a comparison of the current whiteness communication methods in use along with their advantages and disadvantages.

Distinction is made between the methods required to produce paper under correct quality control conditions and the need to communicate whiteness to persons with no experience of colour physics.

Attention is drawn to the particular costs of producing paper of a specific whiteness and the parameters required for the production of white paper.
