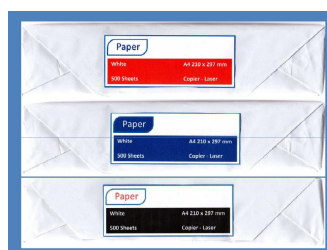
Feedback on the site is always welcome.

After the initial brief market survey we did in late 2007, we have now completed a major market survey of Home, Small Office and Large Office white paper consumers.

The consumers were questioned about paper whiteness, how they buy paper today and about the Makowhiteness Rating System.

Initial data indicates that only a few of these consumers use any values when purchasing paper today, however, most would use Makowhiteness when it is available.

A large number of customers believe that printed words look better and that colours look brighter on high white paper.



Makowhiteness—Making Whiteness Open

Preliminary analysis of the data indicates that the Makowhiteness rating system will allow paper brand owners to position their products whiteness levels more accurately than they do today through the ease of use of the system for customers, either in retail outlets, internet shops or catalogues.
